**Read carefully. Keep this information until the end of the season
*No food or drinks of any kind allowed in the buildings on Saturdays!***

Costs: City of Coopersville residents \$30.00 per player non residents of the city \$45.00 per player.

There may be some incidental contact no matter how hard we try to prevent that from happening.

Practice starts the first week in January. Your child's coach will call with the time and location. Weeknight practice may start at **6:00 PM or 7:00 PM** your coach decides which time and night.

Teams will practice for the first two Saturdays of the season.

Games will start on **Saturday January 16** and continue through **February 27**.

We will have separate divisions, for boys and girls and each age group, if we have enough players and coaches!

Games will be played at 9:00 AM, 10:00 AM, 11:00 AM, 12:00 and 1:00 in the East Elementary and the West Elementary gyms. Check the game schedule every week for time and location of the games. The schedule will be posted at www.cityofcoopersville.com, on the home page under news and events.

Uniform shirts will be distributed to each child during practice.

If games need to be canceled because of weather, you will receive a call from the coach one-hour before game time. If CAPS classes are canceled on Friday because of bad weather our Saturday program will be canceled! If CAPS is cancelled during the week ALL recreation programs are cancelled.

When games are canceled we will stick with the schedule. Canceled games will be made up **if possible**.

Shoes with **black soles** ARE NOT ALLOWED.

No food or drink is allowed in the buildings at any time! Do not sign up if this will be a problem. We now have to pay for janitorial service. If we leave the buildings a mess we will have to pay more and it may shorten the season. We will dump it out if they bring it along. Please make sure friends and relatives know about the no food and drink policy.

There are **no chairs** available and you may not take chairs from the hallway or classrooms. If you want to sit down to watch games, bring a folding chair.
