- Coopersville: 254 Randall Road. From Muskegon, I-96 to Exit 16 (68th ave). Turn right and follow to Randall Road. Turn right on Randall Road and go into town to the City Sports Complex
- Ravenna: Conklin Park, Corner Heights Ravenna road and Blackmer
- Fruitport: Pontaluna Road 2 miles East of US-31; 1/2 mile west of Airline Road in Fruitport
- Oakridge : Holiday and Driscoll fields are located in Holiday Park. South on Holiday off Apple Ave,
- Beach : On Heights Ravenna Road just East of Black Creek and West of Cloverville

Coopersville Recreation weather related cancellation policy

Every attempt will be made to play our games. We will wait until 5:00 in most cases (8:00 on Saturdays) before we officially cancel a game. When the game is cancelled the coaches of the affected teams will be notified. The coaches will then notify their players. Please do not call Coopersville City Hall. Reasons for game cancellation include; tornado, severe thunderstorm warning, any lightning, and excessive rain. During a severe thunderstorm and tornado watch we will use our discretion. Rescheduling games: the coaches of the affected teams and league officials must select a mutually acceptable date with-in 48 HOURS of the cancellation.

Please drive carefully in the Sports Complex Parking Lot. The posted speed limit is **15 miles per hour** and will be enforced by the sheriffs department.

Please supervise your children while you are here. Make sure they do not go in the parking lot or near the light towers. Please accompany your kids to the bathroom. The bathrooms **will be closed** at the first hint of vandalism. Last year they were open one week and someone's child tried to flush down a tennis ball.

Candy and pop machines are located in middle and south concession buildings.

Please do not let you children linger in the buildings.

The bathrooms will be open. They will be closed if unattended children cause problems.
