Motion by Council Member Bowman with second by Council Member Gavin to approve the proposed quote, (Option #2) from Bob's Asphalt and Paving to remove an additional 2,295 square yards 9' wide on both sides of Eastmanville, remove an additional 638 square yards at the entrance to each intersection along Eastmanville, and asphalt 638 square yards 1.5", second course of tack with a HMA leveling course to achieve a flat surface for the final layer of HMA, not to exceed \$90,725.00.
